At Lauds

In the distant east the grey of dawn appears. Nature awakens and praises God.

Manual I: Fiery and dominant Trumpet 8', Flute 8', optional high-pitched Principals or Cornet Manual II: Flues 8' and 4' to accompany

Pedal: Coupler: Flues 16' and 8' Manual II to Pedal



At Prime

The Church prepares for the day's labors and conflicts.

On two manuals, equal in dynamics but contrasted in tone-colors.



At Terce

The Church invokes the Holy Spirit.

On two manuals, equal in dynamics but contrasted in tone-colors.



At Sext

The day's conflict is at its climax.

On two manuals, equal in dynamics but contrasted in tone-colors.



At None

The Church meditates on the end of life.



At Vespers

The Church sings a song of thanksgiving.

Manual I: Principal Chorus including Mixtures with 16' Flue
Pedals: No 16' stops, all Flues 8' and higher, loud Reeds 8' and 4'
The Pedal (*Canto fermo*) may be reinforced by coupling down Flues and Reeds 8' from Manual II.
Couple Manual I to Pedal



At Compline

The sinful soul prays to make her peace with God and for protection for the night.

Manual: Warm and singing Flues 8' including Celestes, Tremulant Pedal: Flues 16' and 8'
Coupler: Manual to Pedal
