The first variation consists of 12 measures of music. It begins with a *dolce* marking and a *pp* dynamic. The melody features a trill in measure 10 and triplet figures in measures 11 and 12. The dynamics shift to *p* in measure 1, *f* in measure 11, and *poco f* in measure 12. A first ending bracket spans measures 11 and 12, leading to a second ending marked with a '2'.
