## SCENE IN HELL 2A

Each measure lasts five seconds. The conductor, using a stop-watch, indicates the beginning of each measure.

Unstemmed notes may be played any time during the measure.

The tape machine should be started with the instruments with the volume level set at zero. During the first four seconds the volume should be gradually raised to the predetermined level. During the fermata the levels should gradually be returned to zero over a four-second period and the tape machine stopped.

The chorus stands during this fermata.

The instruments and tape should be approximately the same volume level.





The instrumental part for 2C is identical to 2A. The tape machine, however, continues with new material (rather than rewinding). It observes the same four-second crescendo and diminuendo procedure as in 2A. During 2C the semi-chorus and the trumpets leave the stage and the remaining chorus members sit. Satan and Hell enter.
